

## **Haiti: Expanded Programs Deliver Hope**

**In Haiti, the church is delivering hope in the midst of poverty and civil crisis through three expanded initiatives:**

**School Fees.** The Methodist Church of Haiti has long provided education for children in cities and remote rural areas. During the current civil crisis, because parents have been unable to pay school fees (about \$250 per child per year), the church cannot pay teachers. Assistance with fees would guarantee that the educational program will continue through this difficult time.

**Health Care.** The church provides health care through seven district health sites. The church has put out an “SOS call for solidarity” to enable them to pursue the improvement of health that is so desperately needed. There is a 50% morbidity rate for children between the ages of 0 and 5. Community-based primary health care includes hygiene education, medicine, and nutritional support.

**Spiritual Care.** Recognizing the importance of spiritual care in times of national emergency, the church is organizing a training event for its leaders. They’ll receive assistance in recognizing and caring for the long-term effects of trauma. The church is in a unique position to bring healing.
