Hot School Lunches. Hunger is a much too familiar phenomenon in Haiti. For a number of years, the lunch program has provided daily meals in 93 schools. It reaches 16,877 youngsters.

For many, this is the only meal they will receive. A meal of beans and rice can be prepared for about 20 cents per student.

As the project has grown, so has the need for contributions. The Haiti Task Force of Michigan, in collaboration with the Methodist Church of Haiti, began this project in order to improve student health and educational performance.
